How to Switch Electricity Providers

- 1 Compare Offers**
As the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's official electric shopping tool, PAPowerSwitch makes it easy to compare electric supplier prices. Keep in mind that competitive offers may not be available in all areas.

- 2 Sign Up with Your New Supplier**
You are free to sign up for service with a new electric supplier by calling them or signing up on their website. Review your agreement with your current supplier before shopping for a new supplier to see if there are any penalties for early cancellation of your contract. If you are not sure, call your current supplier.

- 3 Receive Written Terms and Conditions**
Your new supplier will send you a written disclosure statement explaining your terms and conditions.
