


# Pipeline – Act 127

- Overview: The Pipeline Act requires the Commission to develop and maintain a registry of pipeline operators within Pennsylvania.
- Final & Implementation Order
- Annual Registration Form
  - Due Annually by March 31st
- Pipeline Operators Registry (Active Status)



# Pipeline Forms

- PA PUC Pipeline Safety Inspection Forms
  - Program Inspections updated Annually



## Electric UCTA-8 Accident Report

All jurisdictional electric utilities shall complete and submit this form (or a comparable form as defined in the Code) to the Commission when they experience a reportable accident involving the facilities or operations of the public utility. The Form is due within 30 days of the occurrence of the accident. 52 Pa. Code Chapters 57.11, 59.11, and 65.2. Revised August 2023.


