On 5/4/26, the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) filed a Petition for Interlocutory Review and Answer to Material Questions (Petition). On 5/7/26, the OCA filed a Protest. On 5/14/26, Intervenor Charity Grimm Krupa filed a Petition for Stay, as well as a Response in Both Opposition and in Support to the Petition. By Opinion and Order entered via Notational Vote on 6/1/26, the Commission determined that the OCA's Petition was improper and returned the matter to the Office of Administrative Law Judge.
