



PECO ENERGY COMPANY'S MOTION FOR JUDGMENT ON THE PLEADINGS

Respondent, PECO Energy Company ("PECO"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.102 respectfully petitions this Honorable Commission to dismiss the instant Complaint because the Commission is not legally empowered to grant the requested relief.

1. Complainant filed a Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission formal complaint on December 15, 2008 requesting a payment agreement.
2. PECO Energy was served the above-mentioned formal Complaint on December 17, 2008.
3. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.101(b), PECO simultaneously filed an Answer and New Matter to the Complaint on January 7, 2009.
4. According to 52 Pa. Code § 5.63, Complainant had twenty days from the filing date of PECO's New Matter to respond.
5. To date, thirty-four days have passed since PECO filed its New Matter on January 7, 2009. PECO has not been served with a response to its New Matter. As Complainant has failed to timely respond to the New Matter, PECO is filing this Motion seeking Judgment on the Pleadings.

6. Complainant currently participates in the residential utility discount Customer Assistance Program (“CAP”) and receives a monthly discount on her utility charges.

7. PECO raised this as an affirmative defense in its New Matter.


8. In her Complaint, Ms. McCuff indicates “I want the PUC to order the company to give me a payment agreement where I will pay the budget plus 50.00 each month until my balance is paid in full.”

9. Complainant is requesting further payment arrangements that the Commission cannot establish. Section 1405(c) of the Public Utility Code provides that customer assistance program rates shall be timely paid and shall not be the subject of payment agreements negotiated or approved by the Commission. 66 Pa. C.S. § 1405(c); Walton v. PECO Energy Company, Pa. PUC Docket Z-01593807, Initial Decision issued January 11, 2005.

10. As Complainant receives a reduced rate through the CAP program, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1405 (c) does not allow further Commission ordered payment terms.

WHEREFORE, PECO Energy Company respectfully requests that your Honorable Commission dismiss the Complaint pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 1405(c).




