

**PETITION FOR LEAVE TO WITHDRAW THE
APPLICATION OF PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION TO
EXERCISE THE POWER OF EMINENT DOMAIN TO ACQUIRE AN EASEMENT
AND RIGHT-OF WAY ACROSS THE PROPERTY OF CHARLES COCCODRILLI**

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric”), by and through its attorneys, petitions for leave to withdraw and terminate the Application of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation to Exercise the Power of Eminent Domain to Acquire an Easement and Right-of-Way Across the Property of Charles Coccodrilli, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.82, 5.94(c), and in support thereof, states:

1. On January 28, 2009, PPL Electric filed the “Application Of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation Under 15 Pa. C.S. §1511(c) For A Finding And Determination That The Service To Be Furnished By The Applicant Through Its Proposed Exercise Of The Power Of Eminent

Domain To Acquire A Right-Of-Way And Easement Over And Across The Lands Of Charles Coccodrilli In South Canaan Township, Wayne County For The Proposed Susquehanna-Roseland 500 kV Transmission Line In Portions Of Lackawanna, Luzerne, Monroe, Pike And Wayne Counties, Pennsylvania Is Necessary Or Proper For The Service, Accommodation, Convenience Or Safety Of The Public,” which was docketed at Docket No. A-2009-2088353 (“Condemnation Application”).

2. On February 6, 2009, Administrative Law Judge Susan D. Colwell issued a Second Prehearing Order that, *inter alia*, consolidated the Condemnation Application with the above-captioned matters.

3. PPL Electric’s attorneys are:

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PPL Electric’s attorneys are authorized to receive all notices and communications regarding this Petition.

4. To date, no party has contested or otherwise formally opposed the Condemnation Application.

5. After filing of the Condemnation Application, PPL Electric and Charles Coccodrilli, executed an agreement by which Mr. Coccodrilli conveyed to PPL Electric a right-of-way and easement over and across Mr. Coccodrilli's land.


6. The above-mentioned right-of-way and easement agreement renders the Condemnation Application unnecessary.

7. Pursuant to Sections 1.82 and 5.94(c) of the Regulations of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.82, 5.94(c), PPL Electric seeks to withdraw and terminate the Condemnation Application in its entirety.
