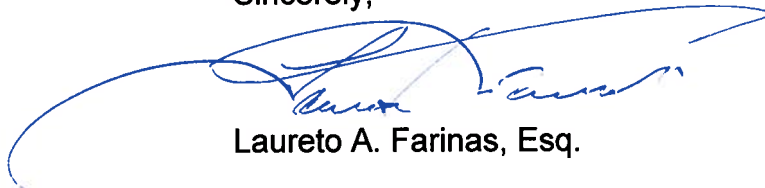
Dear Secretary McNulty:
