MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

1. Pennsylvania Power Company (“Penn Power”) was served with a formal Complaint, on September 16, 2008, from Chet and Michele Duffy (“Complainant”), at Docket No. C-2008-2063047.

2. Penn Power filed its Answer to the Complaint on October 6, 2008.

3. The matter was referred to the Commission’s mediation program, however, the parties were unsuccessful at resolving the matter.

4. As a result, the matter was set for an evidentiary hearing on May 5, 2009.

5. Certain key Company personnel and witnesses are unavailable for the scheduled hearing date.

6. Penn Power has conferred with the Complainant, and the Complainant is not opposed to a continuance. However, the Complainant has requested that any rescheduling does not put the hearing date on May 15th through May 17th, 2009.

7. Granting a continuance of the hearing will provide the Company the opportunity to have all appropriate personnel available to address the Complainant’s concerns and to provide a full and complete record.

WHEREFORE, for all of the reasons stated herein, Penn Power respectfully requests that the Hearing in this matter be continued until after May 25, 2009.


