

**PETITION FOR LEAVE TO WITHDRAW THE
APPLICATION OF PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION
TO EXERCISE THE POWER OF EMINENT DOMAIN TO ACQUIRE AN
EASEMENT AND RIGHT-OF WAY ACROSS THE PROPERTY OF
DAVID MURPHY**

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric”), by and through its attorneys, petitions, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.82 and 5.94(c), for leave to withdraw and terminate the Application of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation to Exercise the Power of Eminent Domain to Acquire an Easement and Right-of-Way Across the Property of David Murphy, and in support thereof, states:

1. PPL Electric is a public utility and electric distribution company subject to the regulatory jurisdiction of the Commission. PPL Electric furnishes electric distribution, transmission and supplier of last resort services to approximately 1.4 million customers in a service area that includes approximately 10,000 square miles covering all or portions of twenty-nine counties in eastern and central Pennsylvania. PPL Electric’s principal offices are located at Two North Ninth Street, Allentown, PA 18101-1179.

2. On January 28, 2009, PPL Electric filed the “Application Of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation Under 15 Pa. C.S. §1511(c) For A Finding And Determination That The Service To Be Furnished By The Applicant Through Its Proposed Exercise Of The Power Of Eminent Domain To Acquire A Right-Of-Way And Easement Over And Across The David Murphy In South Canaan Township, Wayne County For The Proposed Susquehanna-Roseland 500 kV Transmission Line In Portions Of Lackawanna, Luzerne, Monroe, Pike And Wayne Counties, Pennsylvania Is Necessary Or Proper For The Service, Accommodation, Convenience Or Safety

Of The Public,” which was docketed at Docket No. A-2009-2088360 (“Condemnation Application”).

3. On February 6, 2009, Administrative Law Judge Susan D. Colwell (“ALJ”) issued a Second Prehearing Order that, *inter alia*, consolidated the Condemnation Application with the above-captioned matters.

4. No party has contested or otherwise formally opposed the Condemnation Application.

5. The evidentiary hearings on the above-captioned matters were held in Harrisburg on September 1, 2, 4, 8, 9 and 10, 2009.

6. On November 12, 2009, the ALJ issued a Recommended Decision that, *inter alia*, recommended that the Commission approve the Condemnation Application.

7. After the conclusion of the evidentiary hearings, PPL Electric and David Murphy executed an agreement by which David Murphy conveyed to PPL Electric a right-of-way and easement over and across the land of David Murphy.

8. The above-mentioned right-of-way and easement agreement renders the Condemnation Application unnecessary.

9. Pursuant to Sections 1.82 and 5.94(c) of the Regulations of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.82 and 5.94(c), PPL Electric seeks to withdraw and terminate the Condemnation Application in its entirety.

WHEREFORE, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation respectfully requests that Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission permit PPL Electric to withdraw the Condemnation Application and terminate the proceeding docketed at Docket No. A-2009-2088360
