On September 23, 2009 BlueStar Energy Services, Inc. (“BlueStar”) filed an application seeking to become a licensed electric generation Supplier (“EGS”) to serve commercial, industrial and governmental customers in the service territory of PPL Electric Utilities Inc. (“PPL”). On November 6, 2009, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission approved BlueStar’s Application and granted BlueStar a license authorizing it to begin to offer, render, furnish or supply electric generation supplier services in PPL’s service territory.

On behalf of BlueStar Energy Services, Inc. and in support of this Amended Application to serve residential and small commercial customers throughout the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, please find enclosed:

A certification that BlueStar has served a true copy of the foregoing document electronically and by regular U.S. Postal mail upon the parties, as listed in the Commission’s EGS Application form, in accordance with the requirements pursuant to Section 5.14 of the Commission’s Regulations, 52 Pa. Code §5.14.
3. An affidavit of Aaron D. Rasty, Chief Operating Officer of BlueStar, certifying that notice of the filing of its amended electric generation license application to serve residential and small commercial customers (25kW and below) has been published in each of the following newspapers: The Philadelphia Inquirer; the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette; The patriot News; The Erie Times-News; The Scranton

Times; and the Williamsport Sun-Gazette. A copy of the notice that was placed in the newspapers is also attached. Notarized Proofs of Publication from each of the foregoing newspapers and a photostatic copy of the notice as it appeared in each newspaper will be provided as soon as it is available.
