**MOTION OF COMMISSIONER WAYNE E. GARDNER**

In her Recommended Decision in the above captioned case, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) recommends that the approvals granted in the Commission's Order shall expire unless PPL begins construction of the projects within two years of the entry of the Order. I agree with the ALJ that approval of this project should not be open ended, but I am also sensitive to the fact that PPL may need more time to gather all required approvals and permits. Consequently, a three year time limit is more appropriate.

**THEREFORE, I MOVE THAT:**

1. The approvals granted in the Commission's Order shall expire unless construction of the project commences within three years of the entry date of that Order.
2. The Office of Special Assistants prepare an Order consistent with this Motion.
