Dear Mr. McNulty:

Enclosed for filing is a Duquesne Light Company proposed tariff change to decrease the energy charge for off-peak water heating. This rate is modified annually to reflect current market prices.

Duquesne proposes a decrease to the Rider No. 19 – Off-Peak Water Heating Service Energy Charge from its current level of 4.37 cents per kWh to 3.15 cents per kWh, in accordance with the annual adjustment provision contained in the Rider. Enclosed are the original and eight copies of Sixth Revised Page 106, showing the proposed decrease to the energy charge. The proposed effective date for the new rate is March 17, 2010. The work paper deriving the new rate is enclosed for support and is derived from PJM off-peak pricing.

Annual adjustment of kWh rate as required by the provisions of the Rider. The kWh charge has been decreased from 4.37 cents per kWh to 3.15 cents per kWh.

STANDARD CONTRACT RIDERS - (CONTINUED)

RIDER NO. 19 - OFF-PEAK WATER HEATING SERVICE

(Applicable to Rates RS, RH, RA and GS/GM)

AVAILABILITY

Available to customers on the applicable rates utilizing electric storage water heaters equipped with timing devices that control water heating to defined off-peak hours as the sole source of water heating.

MONTHLY RATE

ENERGY CHARGE

All kilowatt-hours of water heating usage at 3.15 cents per kWh (D)

The energy charge per kilowatt-hour of water heating usage shall be revised annually each March 17th to reflect the average PJM Duquesne Zone off-peak price for the preceding calendar year, adjusted for transmission and distribution line losses.

DETERMINATION OF MONTHLY WATER HEATING USAGE

For customers who have installed a storage water heating system that limits water heating to the defined off-peak hours specified and stores hot water for use during on-peak periods, the monthly water heating usage will be determined based upon the heating unit capacities as follows and subject to the limitation listed below:

<u>Unit Capacity</u>	<u>Monthly Water Heating Allowance</u>
30 to 39 gallons	Next 150 kWh of usage after the first 200 kWh
40 to 59 gallons	Next 200 kWh of usage after the first 200 kWh
60 to 99 gallons	Next 300 kWh of usage after the first 200 kWh
100 to 119 gallons	Next 400 kWh of usage after the first 200 kWh
120 gallons or greater	Next 500 kWh of usage after the first 200 kWh


