

PUBLIC STATEMENT OF THE
OFFICE OF CONSUMER ADVOCATE
PURSUANT TO 71 P.S. SECTION 309-4(e)

Act 161 of the Pennsylvania General Assembly, 71 P.S. § 309-2, as enacted July 9, 1976, authorizes the Consumer Advocate to represent the interests of consumers before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC or Commission). In accordance with Act 161, and for the following reasons, the Consumer Advocate determined to file an Intervention and participate in proceedings before the Commission involving the proposed tariff changes filed by PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (PPL).

On December 28, 2009, PPL filed Supplement No. 80 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 201. In its filing, PPL proposes to continue the reconciliation of its Universal Service Rider (USR) mechanism. Supplement No. 80 contains a single change from the currently-effective USR tariff provision. Specifically, PPL proposes that the following sentence be added to its tariff: “Annual reconciliation of the Company's USR will continue unless or until modified by the Commission”. The Company requests that the Commission permit Supplement No. 80 to become effective on 60 days notice.

The Consumer Advocate files this Intervention to ensure that PPL's proposal is just and reasonable. The Consumer Advocate will represent the interests of PPL's consumers before the Commission and seek to ensure that the proposed tariff revision is not unjust, unreasonable or otherwise contrary to law.
