

name for 40 percent of the work. The Federal Highway Administration in 2011 sent an inspector to review the area in response to emergency complaints, and in March 2009 the agency directed PennDOT to meet deficiencies.

PennDOT officials estimated at the time that the work would cost about \$12 million.

The PennDOT project zone of two new additions to major project led in PennDOT District 14's security cover area.

Two new bridge-replacement projects in Crawford County: the Meers Avenue Bridge in Meadville and the Meers Pike Bridge south of Meadville.

PennDOT officials expect to solicit bids during the second quarter of 2011 to replace the Meers Pike Bridge, a single-lane span just north of Route 275 in Union Township. The project, which has been under consideration since at least the mid-1990s, is expected to cost \$1.5 million.

The Meers Avenue Bridge, a Crawford County-owned span

that has been targeted for replacement since the early 1990s, is expected to cost \$9.6 million to rebuild. The project has proposed start by the third quarter of 2011.

The bridge closed to traffic for several years, underwent preliminary repairs that included an examination of possible alternatives before project owners set out to put them upon when the old bridge grows old.

One project on the major project list that is his is a chance in the month ahead is the proposed widening of Ashbury Road

from two lanes to five as part of a project to add more air traffic to the airport.

Cost estimates have grown to \$23 million, according to the January report. PennDOT officials are planning PennDOT officials to review possible cost-cutting measures.

PennDOT is now considering to open Ashbury Road at two lanes to eliminate the estimated \$21 million cost of replacing the bridge carrying the Norfolk Southern and CSX railroad tracks over the roadway, said Don Hall, PennDOT's assistant

district executive for design.

As part of that, PennDOT is proposing improvements to nearby Millfar Road including a bridge that would carry traffic over the railroad lines that Millfar Road now has a grade crossing.

Until said a scale-back Ashbury Road project, coupled with the Millfar Road improvements, would cost an estimated \$26 million to \$27 million, which he said officials believe is fundable from the Erie Metropolitan Planning Organization's project allocations.

Hall cautioned that the idea is still in the early stages, as officials in Millersburg and Lawrence townships — which jointly maintain Millfar Road — have only recently been informed about the idea.

Patrick Supervisor Pete Krus and officials in his township are interested in the proposal but are awaiting more information, including what the project might cost the township.

Real: Couple help others

Both serve on statewide parents' organizations working to reform the policies governing the practice, to attract and a central response to the problem of drug-addicted children who are in care Pennsylvania families.

Chuck Klensk, of a lived Edinboro police officer and an Erie County sheriff's deputy, belongs to the Parent Panel Advisory Council (PPAC), which was formed in 2009. The panel recently completed a two-year study and made reform recommendations to the state House of Representatives, Health and Human Services Committee.

Pat Klensk, 36, an elementary school teacher, is on the board of Families of Violence, which aims to create a high-quality treatment system that is family-focused and readily accessible, supports recovery and promotes prevention.

"My professional mission is to help our country's youth understand that when they are thinking or experimenting with any kind of substance, they don't know if the pill they are taking is real or fake, and one looks to want more. Their life spins out of control over a single decision," she said.

One of the most difficult things that affects even one in the family.

But they can choose to remain one.

When Jeffrey Klensk took to sleeping pills when he returned to a home after his divorce, and when he began to struggle to sleep, his parents took it as the signs of alcoholism. When he failed to get to work and lost his car to court-ordered repossession, the Klensks knew something was seriously wrong. They redoubled their efforts to get him to seek treatment, but did not really expect to come back, too late.

Three weeks later, they met and married Jeffrey Klensk's mother, who had been in recovery for almost every substance tested.

"We were rescued," Chuck Klensk said. "We didn't know what else."

The efforts to "fix" their son began in 2004, when they learned that he was in their power. Jeffrey Klensk went through stages of rehab and recovery, but he always relapsed. He was arrested one of his wife found a doctor for addicts who did not get clean. He's in state prison on charges of child abuse.

The Klensks lost their son without trial. But they know they can't "fix" him.

Through work with groups like Al-Anon and Narcotics Anonymous, a chapter of which they founded in Erie County, they have learned the only way they can help their son is by taking care of his mother.

"It is like a rescue process," Pat Klensk said. "You learn to accept things the way they are. You come to realize that it is not

something you can fix. It is their choice."

Their experience and that of other parents they have met led Chuck Klensk's panel to recommend a cost of \$1 billion in Pennsylvania more than 600,000 people have mental health needs. In 2009, substance abuse and addiction cost the state almost \$17 billion, the panel found. Yet during the same period, only \$1.6 billion was spent on treatment.

The PACC recommends that the Bureau of Drug and Alcohol Programs be elevated to a cabinet-level position. It says services should be made more available by implementing a "211" emergency system with nationwide information and referral services. Some of the parents the Klensks know lost their children to overdose deaths because

admission to treatment was not available during a weekend.

Medical personnel need to learn to recognize the signs of addiction and make the appropriate referrals, the panel said. The Klensks are hopeful that their son maintains sobriety upon his release from prison.

In the meantime, they will be working to help other parents like theirs by staying involved.

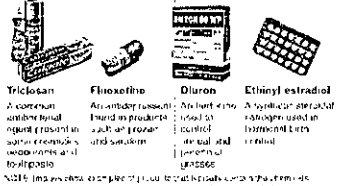
"Both of us have been put on a path we never imagined ourselves following, but we are grateful to be in some good for other people," Pat Klensk said. "It has given us a purpose, beyond our own little family and our other life."

"I was a bit surprised, since these chemicals have been emerging in other bodies of water," he said. "But they are there. And we need to think about what that might mean."

A \$20,000 grant from the Pennsylvania Coastal Zone Management Program might help him answer that. Manno plans to use the money to expand his testing of Lake Erie's beach waters.

He will allow us to monitor the presence of these chemicals, and to see whether they're at levels that could be harmful to wildlife. He's also planning to test the water for at least once a week in the summer.

The grant could help the researchers determine if the chemicals pose a human health risk.

The water study also could help isolate the source of the

pollution, Manno said. That would keep swimmers in the water.

It won't be easy, though. The chemicals are in such low concentrations, it's difficult to measure. They're also very persistent in the water.

"It's a challenge," Manno said. "But it's a challenge that's worth taking on. We need to know what's in our water, and we need to know what it's doing to us."
