Clarification of Information

As a clarification to some of the information you provided in your original response to the data request, please answer the following questions, and include your answers to these additional questions with the original response that you file with our Secretary's Bureau as requested above.

1. Based on your response to Question 1.d of our January 14, 2010 data request, it appears that you are currently charging your PA clients a monthly fixed fee for the services you provide. Further, based on your response to Questions 2.a, and 2.e of the data request, it appears that you intend to continue to charge this monthly fixed fee to clients for the services you will provide as a licensed broker/consultant, but will also charge a brokerage fee to suppliers in certain instances. Is this an accurate understanding of the distinction between how you are currently compensated versus how you intend to be compensated as a licensed broker/consultant?

Our business model currently exists of being compensated by firms at the corporate level nationwide on a monthly fixed fee basis and then we perform activities at the site level in the states such company is located. For example, Kraft Foods is a client headquartered in Illinois, yet we manage their sites throughout North America. For certain other customers, on a goforward basis, other clients (usually smaller in nature and generally those in commercial real estate business) are likely to be charged based upon "supplier collected" model, though this will be disclosed to client. The fee structures do not overlap.

2. If this understanding is accurate, does this distinction represent the only substantial difference between your current operations and your proposed operations as a licensed broker/consultant?
