***PENNSYLVANIA STATE LEGISLATIVE BOARD
UNITED TRANSPORTATION UNION
PROPOSED ORDERING PARAGRAPHS***

The Pennsylvania State Legislative Board of the United Transportation Union proposes the following ordering paragraphs:

1. The Order issued by the Commission in 1973 at Docket No. 19522, entered on or about August 1, 1973 is hereby readopted in its entirety.

2. The Order of the Commission in 1973 at Docket No. 19522, which was entered on or about August 1, 1973 is hereby enhanced as follows:

a. The Operator of the Conway Railroad Yard is required to clear all tracks of all rolling stock and other implements, of any sort or kind, which tracks are adjacent to any track on which a shoving movement is to take place at the Conway Railroad Yard and this clearing must be undertaken prior to the commencement of any such shoving movement;

b. The Operator of the Conway Railroad Yard will take such steps as necessary so as to assure that either a conforming caboose or alternative shoving platform, with such on board lighting as will light a path in the direction of the movement of

such a caboose or shoving platform, be attached to the leading end of every shoving movement in the Conway Railroad Yard. Such a conforming caboose or shoving platform will provide appropriate space for yard personnel to stand while guiding the leading end of any shoving movement in the Conway Railroad Yard.

3. The Secretary of the Public Utility Commission shall mark the Docket at No. C-00019522 closed.
