The York Water Company (“York Water” or the “Company”) hereby submits this Certificate of Satisfaction pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.24(b)(1).

In the above-referenced Complaint, Ms. Katrina Pierce, on behalf of Richard C. Shue, (“Complainant”) alleged that her tenant, Ms. Vinnie McCoy (“Tenant”) should be responsible for the water bill at 468 Salem Avenue, York, Pennsylvania 17404 (“468 Salem Avenue”). York Water has resolved the issues in this proceeding with both the Complainant and the Tenant, and both the Complainant and the Tenant have acknowledged that they are satisfied with this resolution, as also indicated by the attached agreements between the Company and both parties.
