**Transmission Line Construction**

PPL Electric Utilities plans to construct a new double-circuit transmission tap line and substation in Towamensing Township, Carbon County, to strengthen reliability and help meet increasing demand for electricity in the area.

The new substation and transmission tap lines will be built on property south of Route 209, near its intersection with Forest Street. The new transmission tap lines will extend approximately 300 feet, from PPL Electric Utilities' existing East Palmerton-Wagners #1 and #2 138/69 kilovolt (kV) Transmission Line to the proposed Beltzville 69-12 kV Substation. The company will construct a power line capable of carrying 138 kV in the future as demand grows. Initially, it will operate at 69 kV. PPL Electric Utilities has obtained new right-of-way from one property owner to construct the proposed transmission tap line.
