**DEED OF GRANT**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Borough of Lehighton, a municipality in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by its duly authorized agent, hereinafter called "GRANTOR", intending to be legally bound, does hereby for itself and its successors and assigns, and for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) unto it paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, grants unto PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION hereinafter referred to as "PPL", its successors, assigns and lessees, a deed of grant for a utility easement for the right, privilege and authority to construct, reconstruct, operate and maintain its electric and communications lines consisting of three (3) anchor guys, wires, cables, fixtures and apparatus upon, over, under and along the property which said Grantor, may own or in which it has any interest located on borough property, as further described in certain deed dated July 14, 1954, and recorded in the office for Recording of Deeds in and for Carbon County in Deed Book 175, Page 572, situate in the Borough of Lehighton, County of Carbon, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and along the public highway adjoining the said property, including the right of ingress and egress to and from the said lines for any of the aforesaid purposes; also the right to cut down any trees or trim any trees on this parcel 25 ft from center line. The said PPL, its successors, assigns, and lessees, shall not be limited in its or their enjoyment of the rights hereby granted as may be first constructed, but shall have at all times in the future the right to construct, operate and maintain and from time to time to reconstruct additional electric/communication wires, cables, fixtures and apparatus, upon, across, over, under and along subject property.

A copy of this agreement and an acceptance hereof by PPL, shall be filed by PPL with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, and this agreement shall thereafter become effective in accordance with the provision of the Public Utility Law.

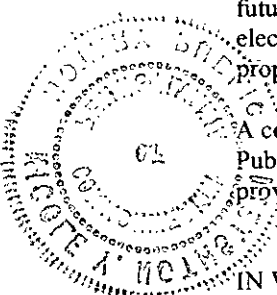

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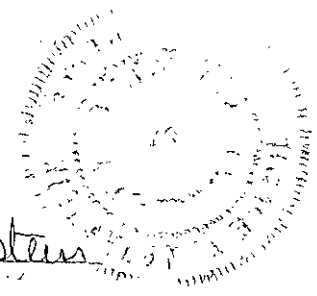

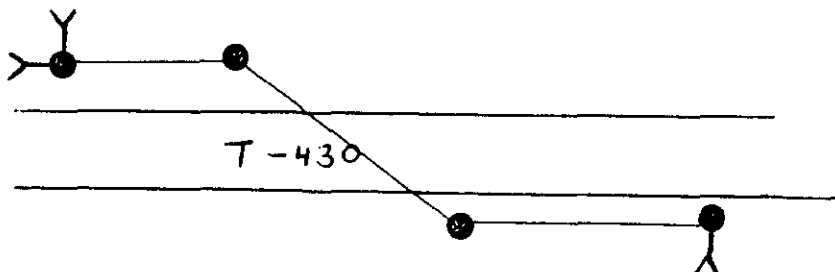
