Dear Madam/Sir:


As you are aware a formal complaint has been filed against PGW in the above-referenced matter. This letter serves as a formal demand that you cease and desist from collections activity against Gregory Berry, including filing a municipal lien against the above-referenced property, until the case has been closed.

By writing to Mr. Berry threatening to file a lien while the above complaint is pending, PGW is already in violation of several Pennsylvania statutes, including, for example, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1410 and 52 Pa. Code § 56.181. Any further collection activity on this account while this complaint is pending will amount to a willful and purposeful violation of the law. If it continues Mr. Berry is prepared to file a lawsuit against PGW seeking: (i) preliminary and permanent injunctions, (ii) compensatory damages for stress, damage to Mr. Berry's reputation and goodwill, and so on, (iii) future damages for the harm the record of the lien will cause to Mr. Berry's future business transactions, and (iv) punitive damages large enough to force PGW to stop its willful disregard of the law.

To prevent further legal action, cease and desist from further collections activity immediately.

This letter is sent without prejudice to Mr. Berry's rights and claims, all of which are expressly reserved. I am sending you a copy of this letter by regular first class mail in case you refuse to accept the certified mail, return receipt requested version of this letter.
