Dear Secretary:

In Paragraph 74 of the Commission-approved settlement in the above-noted proceeding (the "DSP Settlement"), PECO agreed to provide the following information:

Beginning in 2010, PECO will generate a list by March 31 of each year identifying those CAP customers that individually received benefits in the prior calendar year greater than the then-applicable maximum CAP benefit amount, as set forth at 52 Pa. Code § 69.265(3)(v), as that amount may be revised by the Commission from time-to-time. The list will include the customer's usage, discount level, and CAP tier.

PECO has generated the required list. In 2009, there were a total of 21,873 PECO CAP accounts that met this criterion. The following table provides the total number of accounts by rate designation for the 2009 calendar year that individually received benefits greater than the applicable maximum CAP benefit amount.
