

**PETITION TO INTERVENE OF
DOMINION RETAIL, INC.**

AND NOW, comes Dominion Retail, Inc. (“Dominion Retail”) by and through its counsel, Hawke McKeon & Sniscak LLP, and hereby Petitions to Intervene in the above-captioned matter pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.72, *et seq.*, in support of its Petition to Intervene. Dominion Retail states and avers as follows:

1. On or about March 31, 2010, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL” or “The Company”) submitted a request for a general rate increase in the above-captioned docket. The rate increase filing also addresses the issue of the recently adopted Purchase of Receivables (“POR”) program and proposes to adjust PPL’s discount on purchase receivables.

2. The POR program and other elements of PPL’s filing are likely to have an impact upon the competitiveness of PPL’s growing retail electric market and accordingly will directly impact Dominion Retail’s current and prospective business in PPL’s service territory.

3. Dominion Retail is a licensed electric generation supplier (“EGS”) in PPL’s service territory and currently serves over 200,000 residential, commercial and industrial customers in PPL’s service territory.

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
Please serve above-listed counsel with copies of all documents in the above-captioned matter.


