**PETITION TO INTERVENE OF

**AND NOW**, comes Dominion Retail, Inc. (“Dominion Retail”) by and through its counsel, Hawke McKeon & Sniscak LLP, and hereby Petitions to Intervene in the above-captioned matter pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.72, *et seq.*, in support of its Petition to Intervene, Dominion Retail states and avers as follows:

1. On or about March 31, 2010, PECO Energy Company (“PECO” or “The Company”) submitted a request for a general rate increase in the amount of \$316 million dollars in the above-captioned matter. PECO’s filing includes elements which may have an impact upon the continued development of a vibrant retail electric market in its service territory.

2. Dominion Retail is a licensed electric generation supplier (“EGS”) in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and in the PECO service territory in particular. Dominion Retail presently serves commercial customers in the PECO service territory and served approximately 200,000 residential customers as a participant in the Market Share Threshold (“MST”) program. More recently, Dominion Retail has participated both in PECO’s default

service plan filing and currently is participating in both the electric and natural gas Purchase of Receivables (“POR”) filings.


Please serve the above-listed counsel with copies of all documents in the above-captioned matter.

As an EGS currently serving customers in the PECO service territory and that wishes to continue doing so, Dominion Retail has a direct interest in the outcome of this proceeding and it will be bound by any Commission action concerning PECO’s requests in its rate case filing. 
