Washington Gas Energy Services, Inc., ("WGES") is licensed as an Electric Generation Supplier by the Commission (License No. A-110158) to provide electric service to residential, commercial, industrial and governmental customers in the PECO Energy Company and PPL Electric Utilities Corporation territories.

By this letter, WGES requests that the Commission modify WGES' license to include the service territories of Duquesne Light Company, Metropolitan Edison Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company, UGI Utilities, Inc., and Allegheny Power. WGES proposes to serve residential, commercial, industrial and governmental customers in all of these utility service territories.

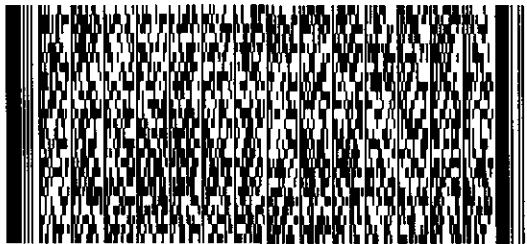

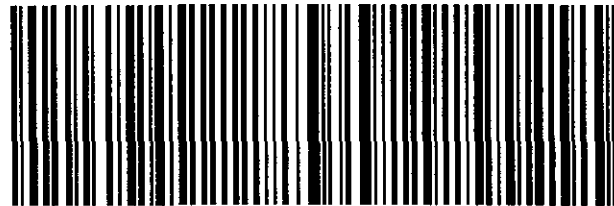
