

2. Richards is a licensed electric generation supplier, authorized by this Commission at A-110072 to provide services to commercial, industrial, and institutional customers within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

3. At present within its customer group, Richards provides services to approximately 204 customers who are provided distribution services by PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL”).

4. On or about March 1, 2010, PPL filed a request with the Commission seeking to increase its distribution revenues by approximately \$114.7 million.

5. As part of this filing, PPL has proposed to change rules for GS-1 and GS-3 customers who are part of Richards’ customer group, and alter the both rates. These proposed changes will directly impact Richards’ customer group.


6. Richards submits that through its group members, it has a direct, substantial and immediate interest in insuring that the proposed rate increase and rate realignment is just and reasonable and does not harm the interests of the members of its customer group. Further, as a licensed generation supplier, Richards, in its own right, has a direct, substantial and immediate interest in insuring that the changes proposed by PPL do not harm the competitive environment within the Commonwealth. As such Richards and its customer group have standing to intervene in this proceeding.

7. Even if other customer groups, generation suppliers, or marketers seek intervention in this proceeding, Richards interests and the interests of its customer group is significant and unique. Richards and its customer group’s interests will be directly affected by any Commission action in this proceeding. Any order of the Commission will bind Richards and its customer group.

8. Permitting Richards' intervention in this proceeding will not delay any on-going activity in this proceeding nor prejudice any existing party or the public interest. Richards submits that the public interest is best served by permitting this intervention of Richards in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, Richards Energy Group, Inc. respectfully requests that this Petition be granted and that it be permitted to participate in this proceeding with full party status.


