North American Power and Gas will have online enrollment for these customers and commission based brokers to assist with marketing. The product will be a variable rate electric supply that will offer savings to the customer compared to the host utility. There will be no long term contract with these variable rate residential customers. North American will also market to commercial, industrial, and municipal accounts but the core business will be residential.

North American Power and Gas will operate in all areas of Pennsylvania. The areas with the most focus will be the areas serviced by utility companies that have expired rate caps. In these areas North American Power and Gas will be able to provide the largest savings to the customer.

North American Power and Gas is a newly formed entity with no financial statements available. The entity was formed on 10/08/09. North American Power and Gas has raised \$1,000,000 in capital to begin operations. Exhibit 19A shows the bank account to verify these funds. Additional capital will be raised as needed in the form of private investments or lines of credit. There is no documentation available at this time to verify additional capital and the working capital in place is more then sufficient to begin operations. North American Power and Gas will operate with low overhead and relatively small forecasted load for the initial 6 months.

This session will focus on regulatory issues. In addition there will be continued education and training sessions for anyone who is marketing for North American Power and Gas.

 - b. The Treasurer or other appropriate officer of Applicant shall transmit to the Department of Revenue by March 15, an annual report, and under oath or affirmation, of the amount of gross receipts received by Applicant during the prior calendar year.
 - c. Applicant shall report to the Commission the following information on an annual basis:
 - the percentages of total electricity supplied by each fuel source

Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.

- 25. **FURTHER DEVELOPMENTS:** Applicant is under a continuing obligation to amend its application if substantial changes occur in the information upon which the Commission relied in approving the original filing.
- 26. **FALSIFICATION:** The Applicant understands that the making of false statement(s) herein may be grounds for denying the Application or, if later discovered, for revoking any authority granted pursuant to the Application. 
