NOTICE

PECO Energy Company will be relocating portions of existing 230 kilovolt (kV) and 138 kV transmission lines, less than 2 miles in length, located in and near the US Steel Property in Falls Township, Pennsylvania.

On May 10, 2010, PECO filed a Letter of Notification with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC) for this transmission line work. A copy of PECO's Letter of Notification is available for public inspection at PECO's main offices, 2301 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA 19101.

The PUC will review and, by order, approve or disapprove PECO's Letter of Notification. If the PUC approves a letter of notification, the transmission line work will be completed without a full application process. If the Commission does not approve a letter of notification, its order shall direct PECO to comply with the application process set forth in the PUC's regulations. If you wish to participate in the PUC process, you should file written comments with:




