

Transmission Line Construction

PPL Electric Utilities plans to construct a new 138/69 kilovolt (kV) Transmission Line to reinforce its existing bulk power system currently serving central Dauphin County. This new Transmission Line will be built within existing and recently acquired right of way of PPL Electric Utilities. This new line is located in South Hanover and Lower Paxton townships, Dauphin County.

The company will construct this transmission line with a power line capable of carrying 138 kilovolts (kV) in the future as demand grows. Initially, it will operate at 69 kV. The new line will extend from the company's new *Copperstone Substation* to the company's existing transmission line along Copperstone Road, a distance of 1.33 miles. A portion of this new line will parallel an existing transmission line just east of Copperstone Road.
