**PREHEARING MEMORANDUM
OF CITIZENS FOR PENNSYLVANIA'S FUTURE**

Petitioner Citizens for Pennsylvania's Future ("PennFuture") hereby submits this Prehearing Memorandum as required by the Prehearing Order made by Administrative Law Judge Susan D. Colwell dated May 17, 2010.

A. Issues to be Addressed

Subject to further development of the record through discovery, PennFuture intends to focus its participation on this issue:

1. Whether and how PPL's proposed rate increases should fund energy efficiency and conservation measures for residential customers who currently are ineligible for PPL's OnTrack and/or Low-Income Usage Reduction Programs and who face barriers to borrowing money to pay for such measures and cannot afford them out-of-pocket?
2. Whether and how PPL's proposed rate increase should fund the accelerated development and use of solar energy?
3. PennFuture reserves its right to raise and address other issues as they may arise during the course of this proceeding.

B. Witnesses and Testimony

To date, PennFuture has identified the following witness:

Topics to be addressed by Mr. Brown include: identifying ways to finance energy efficiency and conservation projects that are undertaken by residential customers who are not served by PPL's programs for low-income customers and who are unable to borrow money to pay for such projects and also are unable to finance such projects out-of-pocket; the benefits provided by such financing; and explaining the need for PPL to use non-traditional ways to finance energy efficiency and conservation projects undertaken by its residential customers if it is to meet the energy efficiency and conservation goals imposed by Act 129.

2. PennFuture reserves the right to identify other expert and non-expert witnesses to provide testimony on these and other issues identified during the course of this proceeding.
