**JOINT STATUS REPORT OF CORE COMMUNICATIONS, INC.
AND XO COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES, INC.**

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 4 of the March 5, 2010 Order Granting Joint Motion for Stay ("Order") entered by Presiding Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Kandace F. Melillo, Core Communications, Inc. ("Core") and XO Communications Services, Inc. ("XO") respectfully submit this status report regarding the status of a related complaint proceeding and renewing their request that this matter remain stayed at this time.

1. Core filed a Formal Complaint against XO on September 23, 2009. In response, XO filed Preliminary Objections on October 26, 2009, seeking a dismissal of the Complaint. Core filed an Answer to the Preliminary Objections and by Order dated December 14, 2009, signed by ALJ Susan D. Colwell, XO's Preliminary Objections were denied.

2. On January 1, 2010, XO filed an Answer and New Matter. Core's Reply to XO's New Matter was filed on January 25, 2010.

3. An initial prehearing conference was scheduled by ALJ Melillo for February 2, 2010, and was subsequently rescheduled to March 4, 2010 in accordance with the January 4, 2010 Order Granting A Continuance.

4. Prehearing Memorandums were subsequently submitted by Core and XO on March 1, 2010. By Order Granting Second Continuance entered March 2, 2010, ALJ Melillo continued the second prehearing conference in accordance with the desires of the parties.

5. On March 4, 2010, the parties filed a Joint Motion for Stay respectfully requesting, among other things, that ALJ Melillo stay the instant proceeding until the Commission resolved the Petitions for Interlocutory Commission Review and Answer to a Material Question submitted by Core and AT&T, respectively, on March 5, 2010 in Core Communications, Inc. v. AT&T Communications of Pa., LLC and TCG Pittsburgh, Inc., Docket No. C-2009-2108186 and Docket No. C-2009-2108239 (collectively, the "AT&T Proceeding").

6. As noted in Core and XO's Joint Motion For Stay, the outcome of the issues raised in the Petitions for Interlocutory Review in the AT&T Proceeding will have a direct impact on this instant proceeding as Core is seeking substantially similar relief in both proceedings and a stay of this proceeding would allow Core and XO and the Commission to avoid expending unnecessary time and expense in connection with Core's Complaint in this proceeding when action by the Commission in the AT&T Proceeding would impact this matter.

7. ALJ Melillo granted Core and XO's Joint Motion for Stay in her March 5, 2010 Order. Additionally, the Order directed Core and XO to provide a written status report on or before May 22, 2010 if the stay has not yet been lifted. The stay has not yet been lifted.


8. On March 18, 2010, the Commission issued a Secretarial Letter extending the consideration period for AT&T's Petition for Interlocutory Review and on March 24, 2010, the Commission issued a Secretarial Letter extending the consideration period for Core's Petition for Interlocutory Review.

9. The Commission has not yet ruled on the merits of either Petition for Interlocutory Review.

10. Core and XO still desire that the above-captioned proceeding be stayed until such time as: (a) the Commission issues an Order deciding the interlocutory appeals in the AT&T


Proceeding, (b) the ALJ grants a motion by one of the parties herein requesting that the stay be lifted, or (c) such other time as ordered by the ALJ, whichever is earlier.


