

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CERTIFICATION OF SATISFACTION OF COMPLAINT

1. Complainant is Minersville Area School District (hereinafter "Complainant").

2. Respondent is PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (hereafter "PPL").

3. This Certificate of Satisfaction of Complaint is submitted pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.24(b).

4. PPL hereby certifies that the parties to the above-referenced formal Complaint, now pending before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, have mutually and voluntarily agreed on the following terms as full satisfaction of all outstanding legal and factual disputes in this proceeding, and Complaint has acknowledged satisfaction to PPL:

(a) PPL will sell the twelve (12) streetlights at issue, and the cable-in-conduit connecting them ("Facilities"), to Complainant for the sum of \$3,000.00;

(b) PPL sells the Facilities to Complainant "as is";

(c) PPL makes no representations or warranties about the condition of the Facilities. Complainant believes that the cable is serviceable. PPL believes otherwise. However, once the transfer of Facilities is accomplished, PPL shall have no further liability for the condition of any of the Facilities. When power is reenergized to the lights, and if Complainant chooses to do so without installing new underground cable-in-conduit to each light, any damage to the Facilities and/or costs of cable-in-conduit are to be born solely by Complainant;

(d) After transfer, Complainant will only pay PPL for the electricity usage for the Facilities and, currently, that cost would be approximately \$5.30 per light per month.

(e) PPL will install an overhead wire from location 56/68 to a new electrical pole located just north of location 58/57. Both the overhead wire and the new pole will be installed at PPL's expense;

(f) Complainant will be responsible for running an underground cable from the light fixture at location 58/57 to the new pole, and the installation of in line fuses, which are set to trip for any power load over that normally used by the twelve (12) streetlights. This will insure that Complainant's streetlights are isolated from PPL's facilities, especially the transformer located due west of location 56/68. The parties will cooperate with one another in agreeing upon the type of fuses that Complainant must install;

(g) Complainant will execute a separate agreement concerning the purchase of the Facilities;

(h) Complainant will pay to PPL the sum of \$1,000.00; and

(i) Complainant agrees to withdraw its Complaint with prejudice.

5. Respondent, PPL, hereby notifies Complainant of the filing of the Certificate of Satisfaction, and that if Complainant objects or disagrees with the terms of the Certificate of Satisfaction, Complainant must notify the Commission in writing of his objection and/or disagreement within ten (10) days of the date that the Certificate of Satisfaction was signed and served, or the terms of the Certificate of Satisfaction will become final and binding.

WHEREFORE, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation respectfully requests that the docket be marked closed in this matter.

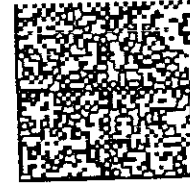
