I am greatly alarmed at the recent notice from PECO that they have filed a request with PUC to raise rates by 10.1% for residential customer usage as of May 30,2010. I know the 10 year cap will be lifted as of January 1,2011. I understood that this would be a hardship for me but the cap ended then and I was prepared for a rate increase at that time. **I do not understand, however, the right for PECO to raise rates for a total of 20% within 6 months, 10.1% of it within the cap period.**

Please help! As a single parent of two children, I value every dollar. Of course, the price for everything keeps going up and my income remains relatively the same. I am worried about my job and about being squeezed until I cannot pay my bills. As an educated middle-income person, I have prided myself on always being able to pay my bills. I am starting, however, to worry about my ability to do this and provide for my children.

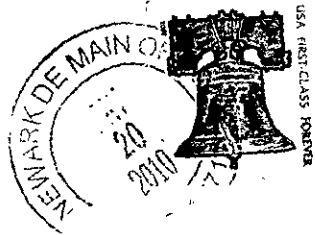
