Transmission Line Construction

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL Electric") plans to construct two short 230-kilovolt (kV) Transmission Lines to supply the new Copperstone 230-69 kV substation and reinforce its existing bulk power system currently serving central Dauphin County. These new Transmission Lines will be built on property owned by PPL Electric Utilities and located south of Hillymeade Drive and east of Copperstone Road. These new lines are located in South Hanover Township, Dauphin County.

PPL Electric will construct these transmission lines with a power line capable of carrying 230 kilovolts (kV). The new lines will extend from the new Copperstone substation to an existing transmission line owned by Metropolitan Edison, a distance of 0.22 miles.
