**RESPONDENT DUQUESNE LIGHT COMPANY'S
MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE**

TO: Theodore Presutti

TAKE NOTICE THAT COMMISSION REGULATION 5.103(c), 52 Pa. Code §5.103(c), PROVIDES THAT YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO RESPOND IN WRITING TO THIS MOTION WITHIN 20 DAYS OF ITS SERVICE UPON YOU.

Respondent Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light”) by and through its attorney Krysia Kubiak, files this Motion to Consolidate in accordance with Commission Regulation 5.81, 52 Pa. Code §5.81:

1. Complainant Theodore Presutti filed the first above-captioned Formal Complaint (hereinafter “the initial Presutti Complaint”) on or

about April 27, 2010, which contained averments that there were incorrect charges on his bill and that he was overcharged from 2008 to 2009.

2. The Commission served the initial Presutti Complaint upon Respondent on May 10, 2010.

3. Respondent filed an Answer to the initial Presutti Complaint on May 26, 2010.

4. Complainant Theodore Presutti filed the second above-captioned Formal Complaint (hereinafter "the second Presutti Complaint") on or about May 14, 2010, which contained averments that there were incorrect charges on his bill and that he was overcharged from 2009 to 2010.

5. The Commission served the second Presutti Complaint upon Respondent on May 21, 2010.

6. Respondent is filing an Answer to the second Presutti Complaint of even date with this Motion to Consolidate.

7. Both of the above-captioned Formal Complaints contain averments that there are incorrect charges on Complainant's bill.

8. Both of the above-captioned formal complaints concern common questions of law and fact. Although the complaints address different periods of time, both complaints are from the same account and the rates were identical in both periods.


9. Commission Regulation 5.81, 52 Pa. Code §5.81 provides for consolidation of proceedings involving a common question of law or fact.

10. Consolidation of these matters will not unduly delay either proceeding.
