Enclosed for filing, on behalf of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL Electric") are an original and eight (8) copies of Exhibits JMK 2-Revised and JMK 3-Revised in the above-captioned matter. PPL Electric requests that you discard Exhibits JMK 2 and JMK 3 as initially filed and replace them with the enclosed revised exhibits.

As indicated in its responses to several interrogatories, e.g., Questions 2, 6 and 7 of Interrogatories of the Office of Small Business Advocate, Set I, dated June 3, 2010, PPL Electric discovered an error on page 13 of Exhibit JMK 3 as initially filed. This error regarding the calculation of the demand and customer components of Overhead and Underground Services affects the results of PPL Electric's minimum system study, which is set forth in Exhibit JMK 3 as initially filed, and the allocation of Overhead and Underground Services in Exhibit JMK 2 as initially filed. In addition, PPL Electric is revising pages 130 and 131 of initially filed Exhibit JMK 2 to correct certain supporting data, and page 22 of initially filed Exhibit JMK 3 to correct the allocation of meter costs.

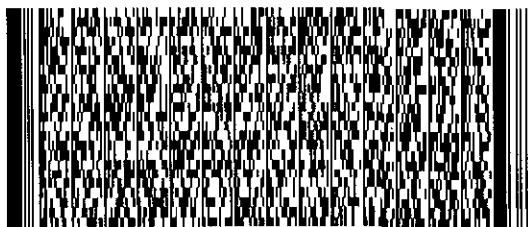

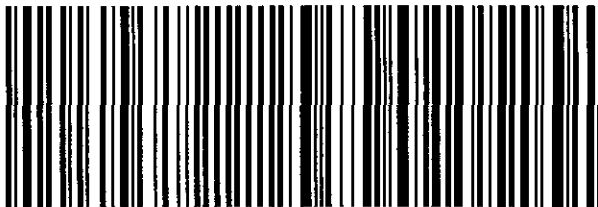
