In its Opinion and Order entered May 21, 2010, the Commission directed PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL Electric") to pay a \$1,000 penalty for violating the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code. This action involved a Formal Complaint filed by Lori and Peter Brickner.

In a letter dated June 14, 2010, the Commission informed PPL Electric that the Company had not yet submitted its payment. PPL Electric apologizes for inadvertently failing to submit its payment, and encloses a certified check for \$1,000.


