PECO Energy hereby withdraws its complaint filed in the above reference matter and respectfully request that the hearing scheduled for Friday, June 25, 2010 be cancelled.

On October 20, 2009, Complainant filed an informal complaint with the Bureau of Consumer Services ("BCS") at case number 2609050 requesting a payment agreement. On October 22, 2009, PECO filed a response with the BCS stating that the customer was currently under Chapter 13 bankruptcy. On October 27, 2009, the BCS rendered a decision establishing a twenty-four (24) month payment agreement for the customer. PECO filed a formal complaint December 10, 2009. The customer was enrolled in PECO's Customer Assistance Program ("CAP") on February 2, 2010 and the disputed dollars have been set aside for possible forgiveness in accordance with the CAP guidelines.

As there is existing precedent governing the issue, e.g. *Anyanwu v. Philadelphia Electric Company*, 55 Pa.PUC 221 (1981), and the arrears are no longer subject to collection, PECO respectfully withdraws its complaint.
