Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Please be advised that the Duquesne Industrial Intervenors ("DII") are filing this letter to comment on the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("PUC" or "Commission") Opinion and Order, entered on June 21, 2010, in the above-captioned proceeding.

The PUC requested that parties comment on whether Duquesne Light Company ("Duquesne" or "Company") should be required to provide a customer list such as was required in the Commission's October 22, 2009, Opinion and Order in *PPL Electric Utilities Corporation Retail Markets*, Docket No. M-2009-2104271. In response to the Commission's request, DII submits that, because a competitive retail electric market has existed in Duquesne's service territory since rate caps expired, the requirements set forth by the PUC to encourage competition in other electric distribution companies' ("EDCs") territories may not be necessary. Importantly, as the PUC determines whether these measures are necessary, the Commission should undertake an analysis to ensure that such measures, if adopted, are cost-effective. In addition, if the PUC determines to adopt measures to further promote competition in Duquesne's service territory, the Commission should seek to ensure the confidentiality of customer information consistent with prior determinations.




