Re: PECO Employees trespass and invasion of privacy

Dear Mr. McNulty:

Please be advised that on Friday, June 25, 2010, I received a call from a woman who identified herself as an employee of PECO who stated she wished to discuss resolution of the ongoing PUC complaint against PECO. She stated she would confirm her identity via an e-mail with her name and contact information. To this date she has not. However, on June 26, 2010, I received a copy of an Order Denying Peco's frivolous preliminary objections. Today I found two men in my fence in backyard, who identified themselves as PECO employees and advised me that as long as my property was "unlocked" they could come in.

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SECRETARY'S BUREAU

My electric meter is in the house and can only be accessed through the house. The two trespassing men had a meter in their hand and stated they were going to change my electric meter. I followed the two men back through the gates and learned that they were driving a white truck with Florida plates stuck in the back window. Terrorized by these two men trespassing and snooping around my property, I contacted PECO at 1-800-494-4000. After 40 minutes I was finally able to speak with someone. When I asked to speak to a supervisor about the trespassers, a Supervisor named Jerry Bandan came on the line. She confirmed that PECO was at my property as a result of the PUC's requirement of "random meter changes."

While I find it extremely unlikely that the PUC would require PECO to randomly change meters without notice to a homeowner, even if so, that does not give PECO the right to trespass and come into my property.

While in the past PECO has threaten me with SHUT OFF, has with malicious, harassing intent and without legal authority shut my utilities off and has attempted to extort the payment of nonexistent gas service, the intrusion of my home will not be tolerated. Trespass / mischief behavior is a criminal act and will not be tolerated under the guise of an act authorized by the PUC or otherwise.

In light of the criminal nature of PECO's conduct, should PECO trespass again or carry on any other criminal act, I will promptly call the police and seek an arrest.
