

**Reply Comments of PECO Energy Company**

PECO Energy Company ("PECO") appreciates the opportunity to submit its Reply Comments in this proceeding.

On May 10, 2010, the Commission entered its Tentative Order in this proceeding. The Commission stated (Ordering Paragraph 1) in relevant part:

That the revised Universal Service and Energy Conservation Plan for 2010-2012 as filed by PECO on December 15, 2009, is approved as consistent with Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, Title 52 of the Pennsylvania Code and Commission practice.

The Commission then set forth a schedule for the filing of Comments and Reply Comments, with Comments due within 45 days of entry of the Order (nominally June 24, 2010), and Reply Comments due with 15 days thereafter (nominally July 8, 2010).


No comments were filed, by any party, addressing the Commission's primary conclusion as set forth above. Indeed, only one set of comments was filed – by the Office of Consumer Advocate (the "OCA"), which stated (p. 2) that: "At

this time, the OCA does not have any additional comments with respect to the modifications made to PECO's electric and gas universal service programs . . . “

The OCA did, however, note (pp. 2-3) that it and other parties should have the opportunity to propose additional changes to PECO's universal service programs in future PECO proceedings (such as its ongoing base rate proceedings) and to have those proposals evaluated in such future dockets.

Given that no substantive comments were received with respect to PECO's Three-Year Plan as filed in this docket, PECO requests that the Commission re-affirm its conclusion that PECO's the “revised Universal Service and Energy Conservation Plan for 2010-2012 as filed by PECO on December 15, 2009, is approved as consistent with Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, Title 52 of the Pennsylvania Code and Commission practice,” and mark this docket closed. Arguments made in future proceedings can be evaluated in those dockets.



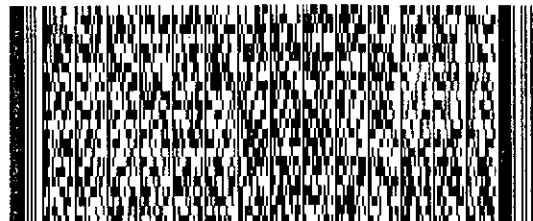
