RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT


The undersigned Grantor, **Township of O'Hara**, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged **does** hereby grant unto Duquesne Light Company, its successors and assigns, for providing, transmitting and/or distributing electric and/or communications services current for any and all purposes, the right, privilege and authority to install, use, own, operate, maintain, repair, renew and finally remove **one (1)** anchor, **attached to pole No. 29711, Item No. 5**, together with the guy wires and other apparatus thereto belonging, upon, over, under, along and across Grantor's land, fronting on **Fox Chapel Road**, situate in **O'Hara Township, Allegheny County**, Pennsylvania, and shown on Duquesne Light Company Drawing No. **WR-341411**, a copy of which has been given to Grantor. Duquesne Light Company shall also have the following rights: to enter upon the land at any time for such purposes; to permit others to attach guys and related apparatus; and to sell, assign, lease or otherwise transfer any or all rights hereunder.

Utility shall file a copy of this Agreement with the Pennsylvania Utility Commission as required by Title 66, Section 507 of the Public Utility Code, and this Agreement shall become effective in accordance therewith.


Intending to be legally bound the Grantor **has** executed this agreement this 4th day of August, 2010.


