**PREHEARING MEMORANDUM OF INTERVENORS CONSTELLATION
NEWENERGY, INC. AND CONSTELLATION ENERGY COMMODITIES GROUP,
INC.**

In accordance with 52 Pa.C.S. § 5.222, Intervenors Constellation NewEnergy, Inc. and Constellation Energy Commodities Group, Inc. (collectively, “Constellation”) submits the following Prehearing Memorandum:

I. INTRODUCTION

On May 18, 2010, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation filed a Petition For Approval to Modify Its Procurement of Solar Alternative Energy Credits Under the Default Service Procurement Plan (the “Petition”).

Constellation is a party in this Docket.

The Petition was assigned to Administrative Law Judge Susan D. Colwell. A Prehearing Conference is scheduled before Judge Colwell at 10:00 a.m. on August 18, 2010.

II. ISSUES

Constellation is at this time still formulating its position on the issues presented by the Petition. Based on a preliminary review, Constellation anticipates that potential issues in this proceeding will include the manner of solar procurements sought under the Plan, as well as the impact of these procurements on retail competition in the PPL territory.

Constellation reserves the right to address other issues as it deems appropriate.

III. WITNESSES

Constellation reserves the right to present direct, rebuttal, and surrebuttal fact and expert testimony, to the extent it deems necessary, in this proceeding. Constellation expects to present expert testimony by:


