Dear Secretary McNulty and Chiavetta,

I am responding to the letter of Replies and Exceptions submitted by the Pennsylvania Power Company, new attorney Mr. Totino, dated July 19, 2010. I am not absolutely sure of the procedure at this point, as I advised in my prior correspondence, where we provided our Replies and Exceptions to "Initial Decision."

We are not at all in agreement with Mr. Totino's Reply and Exceptions provided in his July 19 letter and with all due respect, with this being a new legal firm representing the Pennsylvania Power Company in this matter, I believe the miss representations and miss statements regarding what occurred during trial can easily be understood. Why Pennsylvania Power elected to change counsel at this point is not clearly understood by the Duffy's with the exception to merely muddy the issues and another attempt to confuse what was done and what was said and what had been provided up to this point.

Our complaint were simply but nearly three years have past since our initial complaint to The Pennsylvania Power Company, were by we merely asked them to replace their new meter and the new and larger transformer with the equipment that had been in operation at our home site since 1993. For some reason they do not wish to do so. We continue to feel the new equipment does not operate properly and causes our power usage to show large amounts of power use which we just do not use.

We are simply asking are we to submit a response to Mr. Totino's letter of July 19, 2010.

By the way we have been away from our home for nearly one and a half month since school has been let out. Look at our bills and usage and tell me there isn't something wrong with our meter and transformer. No barn heat of any kind. No home heat of any kind.
