On July 14, 2010, the Commission received an Application from APN Starfirst, LP, for approval to supply electric services in the Commonwealth of PA.

Upon review, the Application was determined to be deficient since no bond or letter of credit was enclosed. I wanted to update the Commission on the deficiency.

APN Starfirst, LP is having Sovereign Bank issue a Letter of Credit in the amount of \$250,000 and will be sent to the PA PUC Office of the Secretary when completed.

In addition, we need to modify Question No. 8. in the Application: Applicant's Proposed Operations; APN Starfirst, LP proposes to operate as a Broker/Marketer AND Other: Supplier. Please see modified page attached to this letter.
