PPL's application process contains inaccuracies in the Exhibits in support of the Certification Application as well as their recently submitted Briefs Document filed on August 11, 2010.

- Exhibit C, Fig. 6 & Exhibit D, Fig 3 fails to accurately show my land and others as residential property.

- Exhibit C Fig. 4 & Fig 5 & Exhibit D Fig 7 does not accurately depict streams, sand springs and cold water fishes and wetlands this project will impact.

- 3.1.6, Government Services does not include a substation of Polk Township Fire Co.

- PPL's Briefs Document Proposed Findings of Fact # 62, filed on 8/11/10, does not make mention to the Polk Township's zoning stance on this proposed project.

- PPL's has failed to adjust the proposed power line to lessen the impact this project will have on my property and quality of life, despite, undeveloped land being present within that same immediate area. Yet, in their briefs Document submitted on 8/11/10, PPL has stated that PPL will employ mitigating measures to minimize such impacts, a statement they have failed to employ during all conversations with this property owner.

- PPL's Briefs Document, submitted on 8/11/10, states they have donated a substantial tract of forested land to the Jonas Mountain Preserve, then later states they resold the property to the Pocono Heritage Land Trust, which is contradicting in nature.

- PPL's Briefs Document filed on 8/11/10, questions the statements Ms. High has made in regards to the manner in which representatives treated Ms. High and states they have not received any other complaints from affected landowners regarding their conduct. I personally have found PPL representatives to be less than forthcoming regarding this project on several occasions when attempting to reach a solution to the impact this project will have on my property and quality of life. In addition, PPL representatives have made statements regarding this project, which I later found to be untrue in nature.

Compile all these inaccuracies with the misleading statements PPL representatives have provided me regarding this project and I feel I have the right to file a formal complaint with the PA Public Utilities Commission.

5. RELIEF

How do you want your complaint to be resolved? Use additional paper if you need more space.

PPL should be mandated to correct the Application and Exhibits in support of the Application and allow the State, County, City, and Township officials as well as the public to review the corrected documents.

The PUC should also look into the necessity of this project when taking into account that there is a solar farm being currently constructed at Pocono Raceway, which is within 4 - 6 miles of the proposed substation of this proposed PPL project. Pocono Raceway has already made public statements that their solar project is being built to supply their power, as well as support the local power grid, PPL's goal with this proposed project. As a result, it appears that an alternative PPL plan accounting for this solar project should be explored as any power lines needed to deliver this energy to the problematic area of Indian Mountain Lakes Development would cross property owned by the State of PA as State Game Lands.. Therefore, eliminating the impact this project will have on numerous residential property owners, while also generating revenue to the State of PA for the purchase of right away to cross the State game lands property, by PPL utilities. (See attached map). PPL Utilities has stated in their Briefs Document which they submitted on 8/11/10, that this solar farm project cannot supply the overloaded facilities unless new lines to connect them were constructed, which is the same purpose of this proposed project, and therefore, not a viable argument.

On a personal level, I wish for PPL Utilities to move their proposed line an additional 300 feet in distance from my property line, to an open field area, which would not have any impact on any additional residences, in that immediate area.
