



**PETITION OF PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION
TO WITHDRAW OR TERMINATE THE PROCEEDING**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE DAVID A. SALAPA:

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric”) hereby petitions Administrative Law Judge David A. Salapa and the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission for leave to withdraw its Application in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of its Petition, PPL Electric states as follows:

1. On August 6, 2010, PPL Electric filed the above “Application for a Finding that the Service to be Furnished by the Applicant through its Proposed Exercise of the Power of Eminent Domain to Acquire a Portion of the Lands of David G. and Ruth A. Fitz for the Proposed Red Front 115 kV Tap Line and the Red Front 115-12 kV Substation in Lower Windsor Township, York County, Pennsylvania Is Necessary and Proper for the Service, Accommodation, Convenience or Safety of the Public” (“Condemnation Application”).

2. On September 8, 2010, David G. and Ruth A. Fitz entered into an agreement to convey voluntarily to PPL Electric the tract of land on which PPL Electric proposes to construct the Red Front 115-12 kV substation and the 115 kV tap line to supply it.

3. As a result of this voluntary agreement by David G. and Ruth A. Fitz to convey the tract of land in question to PPL Electric, the Condemnation Application of PPL Electric has become moot because it will not be necessary for PPL Electric to acquire the land through the exercise of the power of eminent domain.

4. For this reason, PPL Electric hereby requests permission to withdraw the Condemnation Application and thereby terminate the proceeding.

5. It is noted that David G. and Ruth A. Fitz have not filed any document in the above-captioned proceeding. Therefore, this proceeding is not contested. Consequently, PPL Electric's Petition to Withdraw or Terminate the proceeding is governed by the Commission's Rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure at 52 Pa. Code § 1.82. Under this rule, if no objection to the Petition is filed within ten (10) days, the Petition is to be granted.

6. This proceeding has been assigned to Administrative Law Judge Salapa for hearings and initial decision.


7. A prehearing conference in this matter has been scheduled for Friday, September 17, 2010 in Commonwealth Keystone Building, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

8. Because the above-captioned proceeding, as explained above, has become moot, there is no need for a prehearing conference to be held in this matter. PPL Electric asks that the prehearing conference be canceled.

WHEREFORE, for all the foregoing reasons, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation respectfully requests that it be permitted to withdraw the above-captioned Application and

thereby terminate the proceeding. In addition, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation respectfully requests that the prehearing conference in this proceeding, which is scheduled to be held on September 17, 2010, be canceled.
