**PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM OF
PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES COMPANY**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE DAVID A. SALAPA:

PPL Electric Utilities Company (“PPL Electric” or the “Company”), by and through its attorneys, Post & Schell, P.C., hereby files this Prehearing Memorandum in the above-captioned matter in response to the Prehearing Conference Order issued by Administrative Law Judge David A. Salapa (the “ALJ”) on August 19, 2010, and states as follows:

I. SERVICE OF DOCUMENTS

1. The Prehearing Conference Order provides that each participant shall list one person for entry on the service list. Please list John H. Isom on the service list on behalf of PPL Electric. Mr. Isom’s contact information is as follows:

PPL Electric also requests that Christopher T. Wright be included on all electronic mail sent in this proceeding. Mr. Wright's e-mail address is cwright@postschell.com.

2. PPL Electric's attorneys are authorized to accept service on behalf of the Company in this proceeding. PPL Electric requests that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") and all parties of record serve copies of all discovery requests and answers, correspondence, Commission Orders, and any other documents issued in this proceeding on its attorneys in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

3. On April 27, 2010, PPL Electric filed at Docket No. A-2010-2173934 the "Letter Of Notification Of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation, Filed Pursuant To 52 Pa. Code Chapter 57 Subchapter G, With Respect To The Red Front 115 kV Tap Line In Lower Windsor Township, York County, Pennsylvania" (hereinafter the "Red Front LON"), requesting Commission approval of the siting and construction of the Red Front 115 kV Tap Line ("Red Front Tap"), which will be approximately 160 feet in length and will connect First Energy's existing Yorkana-Yoe 115 kV #988 Transmission Line with the proposed Red Front 115-12 kV Substation ("Red Front Substation") in Lower Windsor Township, York County, Pennsylvania. The Red Front LON has not been opposed. The Letter of Notification has been assigned to the Commission's Bureau of Fixed Utility Services for further action.

4. Also on April 27, 2010, PPL Electric filed at Docket No. P-2010-2173992 the “Petition Of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation For A Finding That A Building To Shelter Control Equipment At The Red Front 115-12 kV Substation To Be Constructed In Lower Windsor Township, York County, Pennsylvania Is Reasonably Necessary For The Convenience Or Welfare Of The Public” (hereinafter the “Red Front Zoning Petition”), requesting a finding that a building to shelter control equipment at the proposed Red Front Substation in Lower Windsor Township, York County, Pennsylvania is reasonably necessary for the convenience or welfare of the public and, therefore, exempt from any local zoning ordinance.

5. On July 28, 2010, a hearing on the Red Front Zoning Petition was held before the ALJ, at which testimony and exhibits were admitted into the record. The record was closed on August 5, 2010. The Red Front Zoning Petition was unopposed and, by Order dated August 6, 2010, the Zoning Petition was transferred to the Commission’s Bureau of Fixed Utility Services for further action.

6. On August 6, 2010, PPL Electric filed the above-captioned Application at Docket No. A-2010-2193105, seeking a Commission finding and determination that the service to be furnished through its proposed exercise of the power of eminent domain to acquire a certain portion of the lands of David G. and Ruth A. Fitz for the proposed Red Front Tap in Lower Windsor Township, York County, Pennsylvania, is necessary or proper for the service, accommodation, convenience, or safety of the public (hereinafter, the “Red Front Condemnation Application”).

7. The Red Front Condemnation Application was served on the David G. and Ruth A. Fritz. No person has entered a notice of appearance or otherwise opposed the Application.

8. On August 23, 2010, the ALJ issued a Prehearing Conference Order, scheduling an Initial Prehearing Conference in the above-captioned matter on September 17, 2010, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. The Prehearing Conference Order further directed the Parties to file and serve initial prehearing conference memoranda on or before September 15, 2010.

III. SETTLEMENT DISCUSSIONS


9. On September 8, 2010, David G. and Ruth A. Fitz entered into an agreement to convey voluntarily to PPL Electric the tract of land on which PPL Electric proposes to construct the Red Front Substation and Tap line to supply it.

10. On September 9, 2010, PPL Electric filed a Petition requesting to withdraw the Red Front Condemnation Application and terminate the proceeding.

11. With the agreement reached by the parties and the filing of PPL Electric's Petition to withdraw and terminate the proceeding, PPL Electric does not perceive the need to establish a litigation schedule in this matter.
