ONGOING COMPLAINT

Dear Secretary McNulty and Chiavetta,

Please advise if Mr. McNulty is no longer the Secretary of this PUC Commission.

Again, I have returned to find another "Opinion and Order" regarding the Duffy ongoing complaints v the Pennsylvania Power Company.

It appears however this time your latest document appears to have suggested you have had a Commission meeting to consider and discuss the Duffy exceptions filed on or about July 8, 2010. Duffy's were not advised of such a meeting and Duffy's were not present to defend our position in this meeting. Merely rubber stamping wrong doing is not the answer the residents and taxpayers of Pennsylvania are interested in, neither are the Duffy's.

In our July 8, 2010 letter we asked what our next option was. We were not provided an answer of any kind; however, what you provided was the listing of "Commissioners Present" to decide our fate and an ongoing, paragraph by paragraph rubber stamp support of the Katrina Dunderdale Opinion. You're consistently claiming the Duffy's did not provide a preponderance of proof is flat out incorrect as it was by Dunderdale. Because she elected not to include the hard proof doesn't mean the PUC has to rubber stamp ongoing wrong doing.

I am preparing a document and complaint of wrong doing to the State Attorney General Office in Harrisburg with a copy to its Office in Pittsburgh. In doing so I wish to provide to the Attorney General copies of any and all resumes of your self and of each and every Commissioner Present and of Katrina Dunderdale that have had any prior involvement or employment with any utility company in the State of Pennsylvania. It has long been my belief and the belief of other residents of Pennsylvania that these positions are merely staffing and re-staffing of personal that shift in and out of the utility companies to work at

the PUC to protect the utility companies throughout the state in order to protect their own interests rather than that of the common good of the state and its residents.

For example; as you are well aware Pennsylvania Power Company replaced the attorneys that represented them for nearly two years in this matter. The new attorney (whose firm admitted) after the fact that the new attorney had recently worked at the Pennsylvania Power Company. Certainly a conflict of interest. Yet you accepted his documents against the Duffy's. I see no mention of the PUC regarding this impropriety in your "Opinion and Order". It would not be possible that that individual was not known to have been an employee of the power company, yet the PUC accepted his argument.


This was a simple matter to have been resolved by merely replacing original Pennsylvania Power Company meter and transformer on the Duffy property. The PUC with all its power elected to rubber stamp no doing so. I continue to firmly believe and will prove so something is wrong. You know what they say what smells bad is bad, and if there is a sense of impropriety there is impropriety.

As a resident and tax payer of the State of Pennsylvania I have the right to see the resumes and expect them upon return mail. You can not argue the resumes are personal and private or confidential as they are public officials.

This simple complaint was a simple matter to have been resolved with no cost to anyone and yet the "system" you work in appears to be abusive in this particular case and can not be merely overlooked. I will see the documents will be provided to the Attorney General upon receipt. Feel free to copy the Attorney General with the same if you see fit to do so.

I am deeply disappointed in another bureaucratic system which fails the public general well being and good,
