However, I still strongly protest these charges for gas I don't use, just because it's warmer outside. Upon receiving the W.N.A. charges on the bills for the past six years, 2004-2010, the charge was \$ 177.06 - the credit \$ 71.77 = total paid \$ 105.29 for nothing!

How could PUC approve a charge based on weather not on usage especially since the climate is warming? P&W most likely realized the potential profit otherwise why play with figures.

This is a scam and fraud!! I want it taken off my bill.

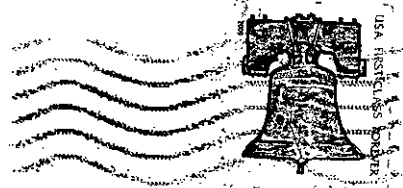
