

**PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM
OF PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE SUSAN D. COLWELL:

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or the “Company”) hereby submits this Prehearing Conference Memorandum in compliance with the Prehearing Conference Order issued by Administrative Law Judge Susan D. Colwell (the “ALJ”) on October 5, 2010, in the above-captioned proceeding.

I. BACKGROUND

On June 1, 2010, PPL Electric filed its proposed Universal Service & Energy Conservation Plan (“USP”) for the years 2011 through 2013 with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”). Under its USP, the Company offers four separate programs to assist customers with paying their electric bills. These four programs are as follows:

- OnTrack is PPL Electric’s customer assistance program (“CAP”). Under OnTrack, the Company offers reduced payments for customers based on ability to pay, arrearage forgiveness over a specified period of time, protection against shutoff of electric service and referrals to other community programs and services.
- WRAP is the Company’s Winter Relief Assistance Program. Under its WRAP program, the Company provides weatherization measures and energy education services to customers.

- Operation HELP is a hardship fund supported by donations from PPL Corporation, its employees, retirees and customers. Under Operation HELP, the Company provides direct financial assistance to customers for overdue energy bills, protection against shutoffs and referrals to other programs and services.
- CARES is the Company's Customer Assistance and Referral Evaluation Service program. Under the CARES program, PPL Electric helps residential customers with their electric bills, regardless of income level, who face temporary hardships such as illness, injury or loss of job.

In its USP filing for 2011 through 2013, the Company proposes to continue its existing USP with certain modifications, including: (1) increasing the CAP credit benefit; (2) eliminating solar water heating as a standard WRAP measure due to the prolonged payback period and extensive maintenance issues associated with this program; (3) increasing the poverty level guidelines for WRAP (PPL Electric's LIURP) to 250 percent of the federal poverty level; and others.

The Office of Trial Staff ("OTS") has filed a Notice of Appearance in this proceeding, and the Office of Consumer Advocate ("OCA") has filed a Notice of Intervention. In addition, Eric Epstein ("Epstein") and the Sustainable Energy Fund of Central Eastern Pennsylvania ("SEF") have filed Petitions to Intervene.

On September 24, 2010, the Commission entered an Order in the above-captioned proceeding ("September 24 Order"). In the September 24 Order, the Commission noted that Mr. Epstein and SEF had raised certain issues with the Company's proposed USP in their respective Petitions to Intervene. The Commission granted Mr. Epstein's and SEF's Petitions to Intervene

and assigned the proceeding to the Office of Administrative Law Judge for hearings and issuance of a recommended decision.

II. COUNSEL

PPL Electric’s counsel in this proceeding are Paul E. Russell, Esquire, David B. MacGregor, Esquire, and Anthony D. Kanagy, Esquire. Pursuant to Paragraph 2 of the ALJ’s Prehearing Conference Order, PPL Electric requests that Anthony D. Kanagy be listed as the recipient for service. PPL Electric is interested in pursuing settlement negotiations with the parties to attempt to resolve all or some of the issues raised in this proceeding.


