**MOTION TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINTS AGAINST
CITIZENS TELEPHONE COMPANY – NEW YORK**

On March 19, 2009, AT&T Communications of Pennsylvania, LLC, TCG Pittsburgh and TCG New Jersey, Inc. (collectively “AT&T”) filed a single complaint against thirty-two different Incumbent Local Exchange Carriers (“ILECs”). The Commission docketed the complaints as ninety-six different complaints – one for each of the AT&T entities against each of the thirty-two ILECs.¹ One of the ILECs listed and docketed was Citizens Telephone Company – New York.

AT&T’s Complaint involved the intrastate access rates of the ILECs, alleging, *inter alia*, that such tariffed rates are not in compliance with the law. Citizens Telephone Company - New York does not have an intrastate access tariff. Therefore, AT&T moves to withdraw its

¹ On April 16, 2009, Chief Administrative Law Judge Veronica A. Smith issued an Order consolidating the complaints into three lead Complaint dockets for each of the AT&T entities. In a *Procedural Order* dated June 24, 2009, the three lead cases were subsequently consolidated into one case for purposes of hearing and decision. On August 5, 2009, the Commission consolidated the ninety-six complaint dockets with its generic investigation into

Complaints against Citizens Telephone Company – New York. All parties to the case have indicated that they do not object to the granting of this Motion.

WHEREFORE, AT&T moves that its Complaints against Citizens Telephone Company – New York at Docket No. C-2009-2098526 (AT&T), Docket No. C-2009-2100107 (TCG-NJ) and Docket No. C-2009-2101274 (TCG-Pittsburgh) be withdrawn.

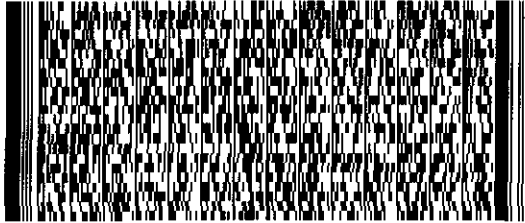

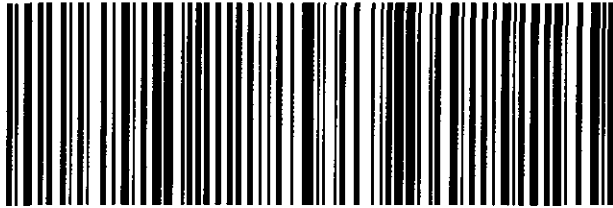
